Dear Parish Family,

This week I want to give you some important information about a couple of issues important to our worship space.

Background and Current Situation

Over 20 years ago, the current sound system was installed in Little Flower Church. During the time since its installation, many advances have been made in the area of sound technology. Additionally, the components of our current system are aging, and we are beginning to incur repair costs.

At the same time, our church organ is approximately 40 years old. Our current organ is electronic, but not digital. Again, much more reliable digital technology is now available. When components of the organ fail, they are difficult or impossible to replace, and we are currently experiencing a problem with the organ that is not repairable despite spending considerable time and money on the organ over the past few months.

Given the age of our current sound and organ systems, the availability of new technology, and complaints that we often hear from members of our congregation, this would seem to be the appropriate time to seriously consider replacement of both systems.

Cost and Plan for Replacement

Many of our parishioners are still in the midst of their pledge period for the school improvements that took place last summer, so a fund drive is not feasible for us at this time. In addition, we do not want to do anything that would compromise the ability of our parishioners to maintain their capital campaign pledges or their regular Sunday offerings.

At this point, in consultation with the parish finance council, I have established a restricted fund for the church sound system and organ replacement. The price tag for both of these projects is conservatively estimated at \$125,000, and we already have a good start with three recent donations totaling \$30,000.

I simply want to make you aware that this fund now exists. If either of these projects is important to you personally and you are in a position to make a donation, we will gratefully receive donations that will be restricted for these projects. At this point, we continue to focus on Sunday giving and Capital Campaign pledges. Depending on our ability to grow this fund, we will, if necessary, develop an alternative approach to raising this money at the completion of the current Capital Campaign.

Please contact me if you have any questions or would like to support these important projects.
