



SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 10:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Dear Parish Family,

As I said last Sunday in my homily, as much as I looked forward to vacation, as much as I enjoyed vacation, I was equally happy to come home.

Last Sunday at the 10:30 a.m. Mass, I was very surprised to see a couple whom I married at St. Christopher's 28 years ago but who no longer live in Indianapolis. Like most people, they loved our church. However, they made a point of telling me how impressed they were with how good our grounds and facilities look.

World Youth Day is being held in Krakow, Poland from July 25 to August 1. At the 10:30 a.m. Mass last Sunday, we blessed Chrissy Vargo and Mark Erdosy who are among the leaders of the Archdiocesan pilgrimage to World Youth Day. Please pray for the safety of all the pilgrims to World Youth Day from throughout the world.

Tuesday is the Memorial of St. Joachim and Anne, the parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Someone recently suggested to me that July 26 should be the official Grandparents Day. If your grandparents are still alive, you might want to give them a call on Tuesday. If they are deceased, you might want to say a special prayer for them.

After last week's bulletin letter, someone commented that the organ seems to be working perfectly fine. The operative word is seems. We have spent nearly \$2,000 on repairs in the past six months. The organ was built before digital technology and has hundred of components that are no longer available. Several features of the organ are currently disconnected and disabled. Before they were disconnected, they were causing the organ to make loud "firecracker" type noises during use. We have been able to eliminate most, but not all, of that noise at this time. The organ repairman assures us that these components will continue to fail and are no longer available to obtain. The organ is over 40 years old. Right now, we are simply building a fund because we know replacement will be necessary and it could be necessary sooner rather than later.



We will be welcoming our high school and college students in a special way to 6 p.m. Mass on Sunday, August 7. There will be a blessing for them and their


upcoming school year during Mass. Please try to make this a priority for your family.
