I want to offer a special welcome to John Kirby and the musicians who will be leading our liturgical music at this Sunday's 10:30 a.m. Mass. We are delighted to have them. Also, I want to welcome any former Holy Cross parishioners who are joining us for Mass this week.

Monday, August 15, is the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary, a Holyday. Because it falls on Monday this year, it is **not** a Holyday of Obligation. Therefore, our only Mass for the Solemnity will be Monday evening at 6 p.m. The Assumption celebrates our belief that at the end of her earthly life, Mary was taken up body and soul into heaven.

On Tuesday, August 16, the Eastside Catholic Community will present Archbishop Tobin speaking on "The Jubilee Year of Mercy" at 7 p.m. in Holy Spirit church. Please plan to attend this event with your friends and neighbors from the Eastside Catholic Community.

previously attended a preparation class. Please call the parish center at 357-8352 to let us know you plan to attend. Plan ahead, as the next class will not take place until the end of November.




We currently have an opening for a full time custodian to do cleaning and light maintenance in the school building on Monday through Friday evenings from approximately 3
