



SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 10:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Dear Parish Family,

Congratulations to Archbishop Tobin on being elevated to the College of Cardinals by Pope Francis last Sunday. Last Sunday was also the sixth anniversary of Archbishop Tobin's Episcopal Ordination. The Archdiocese of Indianapolis has never been headed by a Cardinal. However, Archbishop Joseph Ritter, who was Bishop and later Archbishop of Indianapolis from 1934 to 1946 before becoming Archbishop of St. Louis, was named a Cardinal by Pope John XXIII in 1961.

Today, however, I have some bittersweet news to announce. Tom Costello will retire as Director of Stewardship and Parish Administration on December 31. Tom has done an incredible job in this role as well as in all the other roles he has played in the parish. 

There will be sign-up sheets at the doors of church the next two weekends along with the necessary paperwork that you can fill out in advance and bring with you on November 5th of 6th. Please indicate which Mass you are hoping to attend on the sign-up sheet. This will enable us to get a general idea of how many people plan on getting the flu shot at each Mass.
