

#### Dear Parish Family,

**Our Advent Penance Service will be this Monday, December 5, at 7:00 p.m.** here at Little Flower. Several priests will be available to hear confessions. Parishioners from Our Lady of Lourdes will be joining us. Also, our second graders will make their First Reconciliation at this time. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is a good way to put ourselves in the right frame of mind to prepare for the birth of Christ.

This Thursday, December 8, is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Holyday of Obligation. Masses will be Thursday morning at 8:30 a.m. and Thursday evening at 6:00 p.m. Mary, under the title of her Immaculate Conception, is the patroness of the United States.

Because of the all-school Mass on Thursday, there will not be an all-school Mass on Friday. Mass on Friday will be at 5:30 p.m.

If you can help, please take a tag(s) from the Giving Trees located in the front of church. Names on the tags will be either a nursing home resident or a family member in need.


