Dear Parish Family,

This Sunday marks the beginning of Catholic Schools week. Our school open house is today (Sunday) from 11:30 a.m.

until 1:30 p.m. All parishioners are invited, especially those with young children. If you are unable to attend the open house today, please call the school office and make an appointment for a tour of the school. As I mentioned last week, I would encourage all of you to be ambassadors for Little Flower School. Prospective parents and students are always welcome to make an appointment to see the school.

Friday, February 3, is the feast of St. Blaise. We will bless throats individually at the 8:30 a.m. Mass and the 5:30 p.m. Communion Service.

Today I would like to gratefully acknowledge very generous gifts made to the parish and school by Betty Caito in memory of her husband Phil Caito who passed away in May 2016. The parish staff and finance council will be discussing over the coming months how to put these gifts to the best possible use. We are very grateful!

Also, several months ago we applied for a grant from the Archdiocese to help fund the replacement of the sound system in church. Last week I was notified that we have been awarded \$18,000 from the *James P. Scott Capital Improvement Endowment Fund maintained by the Catholic Community Foundation - Archdiocese of Indianapolis*. This grant, combined with gifts that several parishioners have made to our restricted fund for the sound system and organ replacement as well as a pledge from a parishioner for the remainder of the cost, will allow us to move forward with this project. Work will begin sometime near the end of February.

The Archdiocese awards parish grants twice per year, and these grants are funded through several sources, including gifts to the United Catholic Appeal. Our parish has been the beneficiary of these grants several times in the past. This is just one reason why I want to call your attention to our United Catholic Appeal goal.

The Archdiocesan United Catholic Appeal, *Christ Our Hope*, has been going on for about twelve weeks. We are currently over \$6,000 short of our goal, and only 16% of parish households have participated! The Archdiocese will soon begin follow up with those who have not responded. Will you please consider helping us reach our goal?

You should have received your intention card in the mail, but there are extras available at the church doors. If you have not yet turned your card in, please do so as soon as possible. You may place them in the regular collection or mail them to the Archdiocese in the envelope provided.

Please be as generous as possible to help our parish meet our goal. Our parish benefits from the United Catholic Appeal, both from shared ministries that are made possible (such as the Office of Vocations and the Office of Catholic Schools) and from the semi-annual grants awarded to parishes like ours. Please consider helping if at all possible. I would really like to see us meet our goal, especially in light of this wonderful grant award.

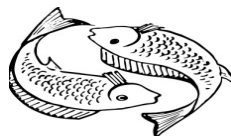
