Dear Parish Family,

Our Lenten Penance Service will be this Monday evening, March 13, at 7:00 p.m. at Our Lady of Lourdes. The Sacrament of Reconciliation not only forgives our sins but also empowers us to live more Christ-like lives. Several priests will be available for confessions, so this will be a good opportunity to celebrate the Sacrament.

Please bring your stewardship intention card to Mass next weekend, March 18-19. As I mentioned in my homily last weekend, every year we struggle to get them returned. Only about 20% of them are returned each year! Stewardship cards help us to budget and help our ministries plan for the next fiscal year. Returning these cards is more important than ever this year because Rick Rader, our new Director of Stewardship and Parish Administration, will be assuming his position on April 1.

This Friday is St. Patrick's Day. Msgr. Stumpf, the Archdiocesan Administrator, has dispensed all Catholics within the Archdiocese from the obligation of abstaining from meat on St. Patrick's Day. The March 3<sup>rd</sup> issue of *The Criterion* contained the following statement:

St. Patrick's Day, March 17, falls this year on a Lenten Friday, a penitential day for Catholics when they do not eat meat or soups and sauces made from meat.

After due consideration of a number of requests and recognizing that this is a traditional day of celebration for many Catholics, Msgr. William F. Stumpf, administrator of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis, has dispensed Catholics of the archdiocese from the obligation to abstain from meat on Friday, March 17.

Msgr. Stumpf said that those persons in the archdiocese who wish to eat meat on St. Patrick's Day are free to do so, but are highly encouraged to substitute some other act of penance, such as special prayer, acts of piety or works of charity on March 17.

### Do remember that our Lenten Fish Fry will continue on St. Patrick's day, despite the issuance of the dispensation.

As everyone knows, St. Patrick converted most of Ireland to Christianity despite great obstacles. In other words, he evangelized the people of Ireland. As we honor him this Friday, we might want to ask ourselves how we might do more to evangelize others.

Because Little Flower School will be closed on St. Patrick's Day, the All-School Mass will be Tuesday, March 14, at 8:30 a.m. However, there will be an 8:30 a.m. Mass on Friday.


#### French students need an Indy home
