SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 10:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Dear Parish Family,

Welcome to the Seccina Memorial High School Junior Class who are attending our 10:30 a.m. Mass this Sunday prior to leaving for their overnight class retreat. We will be praying for you.

Today is the Second Sunday of Easter. Traditionally the Second Sunday of Easter was called *Dominica in Albis* or Low Sunday. *Dominica in Albis* means Sunday in White. On Holy Saturday, after the Elect are baptized, they are clothed in a white garment. In the early Church, they wore the white garment for a week. On the Sunday after Easter, they went back to wearing regular clothes. The Second Sunday of Easter was also the Octave Day of Easter. Easter Sunday was High Sunday, and its Octave Day was Low Sunday.

Today the Second Sunday of Easter is also called the Sunday of Divine Mercy. Both in the pre-Vatican II Liturgy and today's Liturgy, the Gospel for this Sunday is the Gospel of the institution of the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Next Sunday, April 30, 21 children will make their First Communion at the 10:30 a.m. Mass. Because our First Communion classes are relatively small, there is always ample room for parishioners to attend First Communion. I would hope that many of you will choose to be there to show your support for our young Catholics.

It seemed to me that our Holy Week and Easter Liturgies could not have been more beautiful. Thank you to everyone who attended our Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Vigil liturgies and to all our liturgical ministers who make them so beautiful.

Special thanks to the Parish Life Commission who hosted the Soup and Bread dinner before the Holy Thursday Liturgy. Special thanks to Anna Marie Guttierrez who prepared the delicious soup and to all those who helped set up and/or helped clean up.

Also, special thanks to Mrs. Slaton and the Little Flower 8th Grade Class who stayed "after school" on Good Friday to lead the Living Stations for the parish at 1:00 p.m. On Good Friday, school is dismissed at 11:00 a.m. They also performed the Living Stations for the school at 8:30 a.m. Also, thanks to Tom Costello for playing the Stations and to the five younger students who assisted by handing out the Living Stations booklets and by accepting donations for the Holy Places at the end of the Living Stations.
