#### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 10:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

#### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Dear Parish Family,

The parish staff and I want to wish all fathers a very blessed and happy Father's Day. Parents play a critical role in the lives of their children. Thank you to all the fathers in our

parish and all the men of our parish who assume a parental role in the lives of children.

Congratulations to Bishop Charles Thompson of Evansville on his appointment as the seventh Archbishop of Indianapolis. His installation will be Friday, July 28. He is not a stranger to the Archdiocese. Although he was originally from the Archdiocese of Louisville, he studied theology at St. Meinrad from 1983-1987. He has been Bishop of Evansville since June 29, 2011. Bishop Thompson has even celebrated Mass here at Little Flower. On October 9, 2014, Bishop Thompson celebrated the funeral of Fr. Jim Rogers, a retired priest of the Diocese of Evansville, at Little Flower.

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of the Lord, formerly called Corpus Christi. Today we celebrate our faith in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. In the former Sacramentary, there was a beautiful alternate opening prayer for today's Solemnity:

*Lord Jesus Christ, we worship you living among us in the sacrament of your body and blood. May we offer to our Father in heaven a solemn pledge of undivided love. May we offer to our brothers and sisters a life poured out in loving service of that kingdom where you live with the Father and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.*

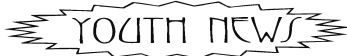

## SUMMERFEST 2017

**I am happy to report my best estimate of the net profit from this year's festival will end up right around \$76,500. This makes Summerfest 2017 our most financially successful festival ever, barely edging out 2014 that came in at \$76,285. Coincidentally, the weather in 2014 was nearly perfect as well.**

A festival wrap up meeting has been scheduled for Tuesday, June 27 at 7pm, when we will look at results in greater detail. Here are just a few high points for those who may be interested.

1. The profit from the raffle was down \$5,700. You may recall the anonymous raffle donation of over \$4,000 last year....it was great to count it last year, but difficult to compete with it this year! Even if we had not counted that the raffle would still be down significantly. The raffle continues to be a major piece of the festival puzzle that has to be successful and needs to become more successful.
2. The silent auction profit was an amazing \$17,000.00!
3. The rides were way up, over \$6,000 over the 3 day period. This was likely a product of the weather and \$1,200 of that went to our bottom line. Presale ride tickets were also up.
4. All of the food and drink booths were way up. A significant donation from Sun King was instrumental to our success at the beer truck. The coke booth had the best year ever. This was all due to the perfect weather conditions. Also very helpful was the fact that we ran out of coke, sprite, diet coke, strawberries, ice cream (and more things that I can't think of right now) within two hours of closing. There is nothing better for gross profit than going through everything you had purchased.

Every year I am amazed at how people pull together to make this thing happen in the best way possible. We had major changes this year, but we implemented them in a positive way and were rewarded for those efforts. The people with the carnival company were so very impressed with the job we did in getting special parish wristbands to folks ahead of time. They could actually notice the number of visitors who had these special bands and they were convinced that our advance efforts were a big factor in the new admission guidelines NOT having a big negative impact on attendance and results. We will discuss our policies and the implementation at our festival wrap up meeting, but I think generally can be very proud of how these policies were implemented and carried out.

So many people went above and beyond, and I feel bad in not naming examples of what I saw along these lines....but I know that if I do, I will miss people and I would not want to do that. Please know of my gratitude for each and every contribution that each of you made last weekend, and in the days and months leading up to last weekend. Everyone involved has much to be proud of. - Tom
