Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. 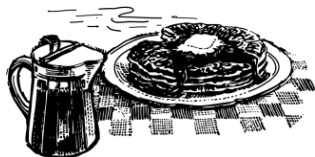
