Dear Parish Family,

Thank you to the Parish Life Commission and all those who volunteered to make Tom's Retirement Party the wonderful party that it was. Also, thank you to all who attended. Attendance was fantastic. Tom gave a moving talk. He made the point that when they married, he and Mary Martha were committed not just to each other and to their family but also to making a difference in the community. Their 41st anniversary was September 11th. Since Tom likes to cook, we presented him with a cookbook, gift cards for gourmet steaks, and a restaurant gift card.

Throughout his tenure at Little Flower, Tom has done his best to enable any Little Flower parishioner to be able to attend Little Flower School. Therefore, we also created an annual \$1,000 parish-funded scholarship in his name. We have asked Tom to determine the requirements for recipients of this scholarship.

Our Little Flower Novena will begin on Wednesday, September 20, at 5:30 p.m. with the Novena prayers, a reading from Fr. Ron Rolheiser, and a Communion Service. The parish has celebrated a novena in honor of St. Therese since 1927. On days 2 through 8, the Novena will take place on seven consecutive **weekday** evenings at 5:30 p.m., omitting Saturday and Sunday. The Solemn Closing of the Novena (Day 9) will take place at the 5:00 p.m. Mass on Saturday, September 30, as part of the parish celebration of the Feast of St. Therese. We will celebrate the Feast of St. Therese at all the Masses on the weekend of September 30-October 1.

As many of you have noticed, the Adoration Chapel has been closed since Saturday, August 12. I know that there are a lot of questions concerning this. On the evening of August 12, I discovered someone had disturbed quite a few things in the church, the sacristy, the music room, and the ushers' room. At the same time, no one was in the chapel with the Blessed Sacrament. It became clear that we had a security problem as well as a problem with a lack of adorers.

The first thing we did was change the security code on the door. Second, the locks on sacristy door and music room door are being repaired so that they can be locked at all times other than when there are Masses or Communion services. Until they can lock, we are not sharing the code on the door except on a need-to-know basis. Repairing those locks is taking a lot longer than we expected.

As soon as the locks are repaired, the chapel will be reopened for daytime/early evening hours. I have spoken to the East Deanery pastors about coordinating a Sunday for all of us to promote adoration. We need to find support in other parishes to see if there are enough volunteers in the deanery to reopen the chapel on a 24-hour basis. We hope to do this as soon as we know that we are able to re-open the chapel.

Again, this has been a long journey. Thank you for your patience.

Finally, as some of you know, I have been dealing with some health issues the last couple of weeks. This caused me to miss Masses on Wednesday and Friday, September 6 & 8. When a priest becomes ill, this is when the shortage of priests is felt most strongly. When I found out on Wednesday that I could be limited in what I would be able to do the rest of the week, my first thought was Charlie McConahay's funeral on Thursday, Valerie Michael and Ben Church's wedding on Saturday, and the weekend Masses. Fortunately, we were able to find back-ups for all of them, although I was able to be present for them all. Since the issues are still not resolved, I am still seeing doctors. Please say a prayer for me!


