

### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 10:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.



**Dear Parish Family,**

This weekend we are celebrating the Feast of St. Therese, our patron saint. However, we are celebrating the Solemn Closing of the Novena at the 5:00 p.m. Mass this Saturday, September 30.

Although her feast today is October 1, it was originally September 30, the anniversary of her death. She died 120 years ago! However, when most of us who are older were growing up, her feast was on October 3.

Our Adoration Chapel re-opened this past Monday. At least temporarily, the Chapel will be open from 9:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. What this means is that Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will only be during those hours. Also, for security reasons, the sacristy and the music room will be locked when not in use. Our current plan is to recruit more adorers in the East Deanery parishes by asking the East Deanery pastors to include the Adoration Chapel in a homily and to have sign-ups after Mass.

There are several special feasts this week.

Monday, October 2, is the Memorial of the Holy Guardian Angels. The Guardian Angel prayer was the first prayer I memorized in first grade.

Wednesday, October 3, is the Feast of St. Theodore Guerin, Virgin. Mother Theodore was the foundress of the Sisters of Providence in Terre Haute. She is the principal patroness of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis.

Thursday, October 4, is the Memorial of St. Francis Assisi. St. Francis is one of the most popular Catholic saints. When I was in school, we always had a free day on October 4 because St. Francis was the patron saint of the Sisters of St. Francis, Oldenburg, who were our teachers. Please pray for the Sisters of St. Francis, Oldenburg.

Saturday, October 7, is the Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary. The Rosary is one of the principal devotions to the Blessed Virgin Mary. When those of us who are older were growing up, there were three sets of mysteries: the Joyful, Sorrowful, and Glorious Mysteries. St. Pope John Paul II added the Luminous Mysteries: the Baptism in the Jordan, the Wedding at Cana, the Proclamation of the Kingdom, the Transfiguration, and the Institution of the Eucharist.

For those who were not at Mass last weekend, I announced that although the biopsy on my neck was not definitive, it indicated that the growth was most likely an infection. I go back to the doctor in two weeks. Thank you all for your prayers. I am amazed at all the people praying for me. It certainly has been both strengthening and comforting.
