Dear Parish Family,

Monday, January 15, our nation celebrates the birthday of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Both our parish office and our school will be closed in honor of Dr. King. I am

always moved by Dr. King's words in his "I Have A Dream" speech delivered on the steps of the Lincoln Memorial on August 28, 1963: "I have a dream that my four children will one day live in a nation where they will not be judged by the color of their skin but by the content of their character." In that same speech, Dr. King reminded his listeners, "...unearned suffering is redemptive." Monday evening's 5:30 Mass will be a Votive Mass for Promoting Harmony.

Friday begins the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity (January 18-25). The theme for 2018 is "Your Right Hand, O Lord, Glorious in Power" (Exodus 15:6). According to the Greymoor Ecumenical and Interreligious Institute, "Throughout the Biblical narrative of salvation, an unmistakable motif is the unrelenting determination of the Lord to form a people whom He could call His own...The prophets repeatedly remind Israel that their covenant demanded that relationships among its various social groups should be characterized by justice, compassion and mercy. Reconciliation often demands repentance, reparation and healing of memories."

Thank you to all who have volunteered to help with *Discovering Christ* and for all who signed up to participate. The *Invite* Committee and I are very happy with your response. As of this past Tuesday, 48 people had signed up! Again, registrations are limited to the first 100 people. If you have not signed up and would like to participate, please do so as soon as possible.
