

If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

Dear Parish Family,

Today we celebrate Pentecost, the sending of the Holy Spirit. The word *Pentecost* means the fiftieth day. Pentecost was the Greek name given to the Jewish Feast of Weeks, which fell on the fiftieth

day after Passover. Our Pentecost falls on the fiftieth day after Easter. Today also marks the end of the liturgical season of Easter. During the Easter Season the Paschal or Easter Candle is lit at all Masses. After today, the Paschal or Easter candle will only be lit for baptisms and funerals.

Congratulations to Fr. Joe Moriarty, a son of Little Flower, who is celebrating his 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of ordination with Mass at 1:00 p.m. this Sunday followed by a dessert reception in Duffey Hall. Fr. Joe is the son of Pat and Margaret Moriarty. He is a graduate of Little Flower Grade School and Seccina Memorial High School. He was ordained on June 5, 1993. Since 2016, he has been the rector of Bishop Simon Bruté College Seminary here in Indianapolis.

This year Pope Francis has added the Memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church, to the Roman Calendar to be celebrated each year on the Monday after Pentecost.
