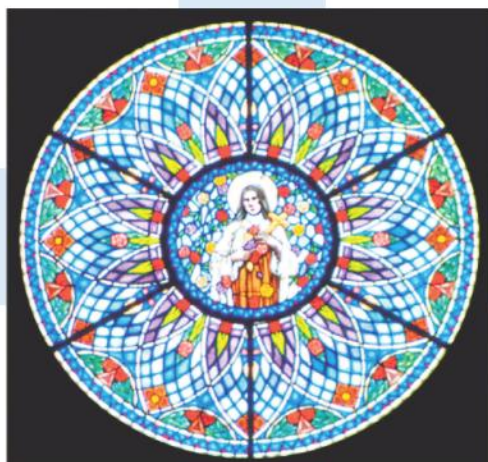

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 10:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

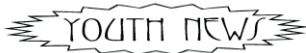

SUMMERFEST 2018

Our best estimate is that the net profit from this year's festival will end up very close to \$68,000. This is about \$8,000 less than last year. The loss of the rummage sale contributed to this decline, as well as overall decreased attendance. That being said, we did experience increases in several areas, including the stained glass raffle, sponsorships, and presale ride tickets. The festival profit will cover the majority of the cost of the final HVAC units and flat roofs on the church building.

A festival wrap-up meeting has been scheduled for Wednesday, June 27, at 7 p.m. when we will look at results in greater detail.

Overall I consider the festival to have been a success. The weather was agreeable, no major issues arose, and a good time was had by all who attended.

Many thanks goes out to all who were involved in pulling off Summerfest 2018. I received many kind and supportive comments throughout the weekend that helped ease the anxiety of my first festival. I would like to turn that back around and say it wouldn't have been possible without all of the hard work, dedication, and commitment from everyone involved – from the leadership team on down to everyone who came out to have a good time.
