If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

#### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.



Dear Parish Family,

We want to welcome Fr. John Maung who is the celebrant and homilist for the Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass and the Sunday 8:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Masses. We also want to welcome Fr. Jim Bonke who is the celebrant and homilist for the 10:30 a.m. Mass. I am deeply grateful to both for their willingness to celebrate these Masses with such short notice after Fr. George Menke's death on Friday, June 15.

Next weekend, July 7-8, Fr. Mike Barton will be here for all the Masses and for confessions. Fr. Mike is a Comboni missionary and will be asking for your prayers and support for the Comboni missions.

Fr. Mike is a son of Little Flower Parish. He was baptized, confirmed, and even ordained a priest here at Little Flower. He attended high school at Sacred Heart Seminary in Cincinnati, Ohio, did the 2-year novitiate formation program in Monroe, Michigan, and then finished college and philosophy in Cincinnati. Fr. Mike did his theological studies in Spain where he made his perpetual profession of vows and was ordained a deacon.

Following ordination to the priesthood in 1976, Fr. Mike spent 2 years in Cairo, Egypt, learning Arabic and in 1978 was assigned to South Sudan where he was parish priest of four large parishes for nine years. Then he was called back to the United States to do mission and vocation promotion ministry at their community in Monroe, Michigan for 6 years. In 1993 Fr. Mike was sent back to South Sudan where he has served as pastor and educator.

Please welcome Fr. Mike warmly, and please be as generous as possible to the Comboni missions.

While I am on vacation, there will be no weekday Masses at Little Flower. Weekday Masses at Holy Spirit are 8:30 a.m. Monday through Saturday and 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday. Weekday Masses at Lourdes are at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday and Thursday and 8:15 a.m. on Wednesday and Friday. Please note the special times for July 4<sup>th</sup>.

Last Sunday at the 10:30 a.m. Mass our grade school Summer Choir sang for the first time. They did an excellent job under the leadership of Tom Costello and Rachel Shaffer. When I first came to Little Flower 15 years ago, I was so impressed by Summer Choir. They brought so much life and energy to the Masses at which they sang. I encourage you to come to support them this summer. After today, they will sing at the 10:30 a.m. Masses on the following Sundays: July 15, July 29, and August 5.

In addition, our Youth Choir, open to students Grade 8 through high school, sings on the first and fourth Sundays of each month at the 6 p.m. Mass. The 6:00 p.m. Mass typically has the most visitors. Every time they sing, we receive compliments on their singing.

I would like to suggest that parents encourage their children to participate in these opportunities. This year we had trouble getting enough kids for Summer Choir. Likewise, only one new 8<sup>th</sup> grader joined Youth Choir this year. Encouraging their participation in Summer Choir or Youth Choir helps foster a culture of generosity among our young people.

Likewise, if you have children entering pre-4's through 4<sup>th</sup> grade this fall, I would encourage you to register them for Vacation Bible School. Dates for Vacation Bible School will be Monday, July 16, through Friday, July 20, from 6:30-8:30 p.m. each evening. Vacation Bible School is a way to foster the faith of younger children during the summer. Additional information can be found elsewhere in today's bulletin.

Before her death, parishioner Betty Caito gave large gifts to Little Flower Parish and Little Flower School in memory of her husband Phil Caito who preceded her in death. The school gift is being used this summer to do an extensive renovation of the cafeteria (excluding the kitchen). Work began immediately after the festival and will continue for most of the summer. We are very grateful to Betty for her generosity.
