This Sunday, September 30, from 7:15 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. in Duffey Hall, Maureen Sweeney, a parishioner and a therapist, will facilitate a forum that will provide an opportunity for parishioners to share their thoughts and feelings about recent events in the Catholic Church and the impact these events have had on them. I will also be there to hear your thoughts and feelings.

Monday, October 1, is the Feast of St. Therese. There will be an All-School Mass on Monday at 8:30 a.m.

The Solemn Closing of the Little Flower Novena will be Monday, October 1, at 5:30 p.m. The Solemn Closing will consist of the traditional procession with the

relic of St. Therese and those preparing for First Communion dropping rose petals, the novena prayers, and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. I hope that many of you will make a special effort to attend. In 1927, the first year of the novena, 1500 persons were present for the closing!

We will also celebrate the Feast of St. Therese at all the Masses next weekend, October 6 and 7.

Likewise, I hope many of you will be able to attend the **Parish Appreciation Brunch next Sunday, October 7, in the Social Hall after the 10:30 a.m. Mass**. This brunch is a "thank you" for the time, talent, and treasure generously given by our parishioners that make our parish the wonderful faith community that we all enjoy. Please come and allow us to show our gratitude in this small way. Everything will be provided, so just bring yourselves. Please RSVP to the parish center at 317-357-8352 as soon as possible.

Wednesday, October 3, which was formerly the Feast of St. Therese, is now the Feast of St. Mother Theodore Guerin, the foundress of the Sisters of Providence of Terre Haute and the principal patroness of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis. She is the only Indiana saint.

Thursday, October 4, is the feast of St. Francis of Assisi. Please pray for the living and deceased Sisters of St. Francis from Oldenburg. Oldenburg Franciscans staffed Little Flower School from its beginning until approximately 1990.

On September 8, 2018, Sr. Irwin Marie Kreimer died on the 80th anniversary of her entrance into the Oldenburg Franciscan community. At the time of her death, she was 97 years old. Her first assignment was here at Little Flower from 1941 to 1945. Several years ago, she attended one of our all-class reunions. After she talked to one of her former students, she would tell me a story about that student from when she taught him or her. Whenever I visited Oldenburg, I always made a point to visit her.

On September 19, Sr. Marietta Sharkey died. Sr. Marietta graduated from Little Flower School in 1948. In 2010, we honored her as an Outstanding Alumna of Little Flower School. She was a Franciscan Sister for 66 years.

Please pray for both Sr. Irwin Marie and Sr. Marietta and for their families.
