Dear Parish Family,

This weekend we as a parish are celebrating the Feast of St. Therese. Her actual feast day is October 1. This is the third date of her feast. Her feast was originally on September 30, the anniversary of her death in 1897. From 1927-1969, her feast day was on October 3. One of the reasons for this date was because October 1 was not available because of the then current liturgical calendar. One website suggested that it was moved to October 1 because of an ancient

custom of celebrating a saint's entry into heaven on the day following their death.

If you are reading this Saturday evening or Sunday morning, I hope you will be able to attend the Parish Appreciation Brunch in the Social Hall after the 10:30 a.m. Mass. This brunch is a "thank you" for the time, talent, and treasure generously given by our parishioners that make our parish the wonderful faith community that we all enjoy. Please come and allow us to show our gratitude in this small way. Everything will be provided, so just bring yourselves.

One of this year's goals for the Eastside Catholic Community, our *Connected in the Spirit* cohort, is to address food insecurity concerns on the Eastside. To do this, we are trying to establish an Eastside Catholic Community Food Insecurity Committee. Each cohort parish has been asked to seek at least one member of the parish interested in this issue to meet and study what is currently being done at each parish as well as at other Eastside churches and community organizations to alleviate food insecurity. Traditionally October has been the month of the Most Holy Rosary. The feast of the Holy Rosary is October 7. During these difficult times in the Church, this year Pope Francis has asked Catholics throughout the world to pray the Rosary daily during October ending it with the invocation "We fly to Thy protection, O Holy Mother of God. Do not despise our petitions in our necessities, but deliver us always from all dangers, O Glorious and Blessed Virgin." He has also asked us to pray to St. Michael the Archangel: "Saint Michael Archangel, defend us in battle, be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil; may God rebuke him, we humbly pray; and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl through the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen."

I want to thank Maureen Sweeney for facilitating the forum last Sunday evening to provide parishioners with the opportunity to share their thoughts and feelings about recent events in the Catholic Church and the impact these events have had on them. Also, I want to thank Ron Sharp for taking the minutes. After they are reviewed and revised, we will forward them to the Archbishop.






