

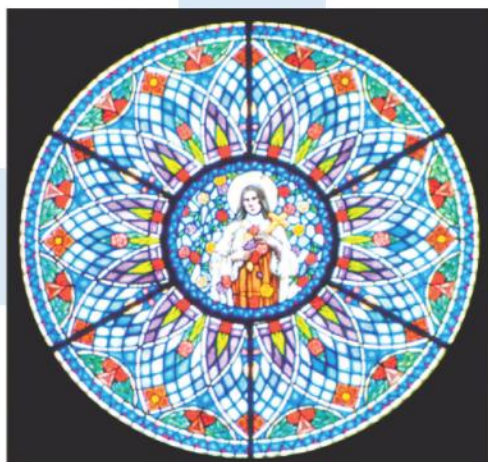

### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 10:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

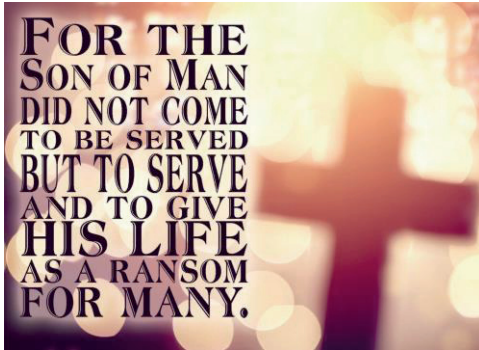

Dear Parish Family,

This Sunday at the 6 p.m. Mass we will celebrate the Rite of Enrollment for our high school Confirmation candidates. This Rite will mark the beginning of their preparation to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation from Archbishop Thompson on Tuesday, May 21, 2019, at Sts. Peter and Paul Cathedral.

Parents, if your children are not baptized or not baptized Catholic, please note the announcement elsewhere in the bulletin regarding an information meeting concerning the Rite of Christian Initiation for Children (RCIC). This meeting will be Tuesday, October 30, at 6:00 p.m. in the Parish Center. The RCIC is open to all children between the ages of 8 and 17.

This Monday, October 22, we celebrate the feast of Saint Pope John Paul II. In 1978, Pope John Paul II became the first non-Italian Pope in more than 400 years. As Pope, he visited more than 100 countries. He emphasized evangelization and re-evangelization. He played a major role both in the collapse of communism in Poland and in the collapse of the Soviet Union. Pope John Paul II died on April 2, 2005. Pope Francis canonized Saint Pope John XXIII and Saint Pope John Paul II on April 27, 2014.

This Wednesday, October 24, is the 74<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the death of Fr. Thomas Scecina for whom Scecina Memorial High School is named. Fr. Scecina was born on September 16, 1910, in Vicksburg in Greene County, Indiana. After studies at St. Meinrad Seminary, he was ordained a priest of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis on June 11, 1935. Father Tom faithfully served God and country as a military chaplain during World War II before perishing at sea with other Prisoners of War on October 24, 1944. One can argue that Fr. Scecina died a martyr. Scecina Memorial High School opened in 1953.

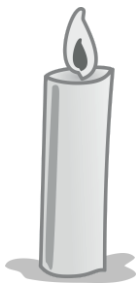
On Thursday, October 11, the Archdiocese released a list of priests with at least one credible accusation of sexual abuse against a child or adolescent. When we were reading about Cardinal McCarrick or the Pennsylvania Grand Jury Report, most of us were upset and angry. However, this list touches us more personally. We may have known some of these priests or at least known their names. For so many people, these revelations have shaken their trust in the Church and/or even their faith in God.

As you process these latest revelations, please remember that many of these accusations go as far back as the 1940's. Many of the priests on the list are deceased, and many were deceased before any accusations were made. The latest is 1997. Since 2002, the Church in the United States has had background checks, codes of conduct, and Safe and Sacred training for all priests and others who minister to children. Additionally, candidates for the priesthood are psychologically screened. The Church in the United States is working hard to prevent abuse of any kind by priests and others who minister in the name of the Church. Also, it is important to remember that since 1940, at least 940 priests and 68 deacons have served in the Archdiocese of Indianapolis. Most of them have served honorably, generously, and faithfully.

These last few weeks have been some of the most difficult times of my priesthood. My heart and my prayers go out to all the victims of abuse. However, my heart and my prayers also go out to all of you who are struggling with faith in God or trust in the Church. During these times of struggle, I would invite you to remember all the times you have experienced the presence and love of God in your lives and all the times you have experienced that presence and love through the Church. If you are having significant struggles and would like to talk privately, please do not hesitate to call.
