SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 10:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Dear Parish Family,

This Wednesday evening, October 31, will be our annual Halloween Party from 6 to 8 p.m. in Duffey Hall. This is a great time for children to trick or treat and celebrate Halloween in a safe

environment. There is still a need for individually wrapped bags of candy. They may be dropped off in the baskets that are at the doors of church, at school, or in the Parish Office. Please remember that this Halloween Party is not just for parishioners but also for all our young neighbors. What makes our Halloween Party special is that it is an outreach to our neighborhood and community. Please see the flyer elsewhere in the bulletin.

Thursday, November 1, is the Solemnity of All Saints, a Holyday of Obligation. **Masses will be at 8:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.** The 6:00 p.m. Mass will be our annual **Mass of Remembrance**. I would encourage all of you to attend and pray for all those who have died and been buried from our parish in the last year. Our Mass of Remembrance is important for the families who have lost family members this past year, but it is also important for us as a parish. It is important that we support families of parishioners who have lost loved ones, but it is also important that we remember and celebrate the lives of so many individuals who were an important part of our parish.

Friday, November 2, is the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, commonly called All Souls Day. **Masses will be at 8:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.** On this day, we pray for all the faithful departed who may need our prayers. Although not a Holyday of Obligation, traditionally large numbers of Catholics also attended Mass on All Souls Day to pray for all those who have gone before us in death but remain in need of our prayers.

Both All Saints Day and All Souls Day remind us of the unbreakable bond between us and those who have gone before us in death. We ask all the saints in heaven to pray for us, and we pray for all the souls in Purgatory.

This week we want to remember Teresa Eckrich, who served as Little Flower's Music Director for 35 years and Little Flower School's Music Teacher for 30 years. Over the years, many people have told me that they are members of Little Flower because of our music. She caused many of our students to be interested in music and to develop their musical abilities. Teresa died one year ago this past Tuesday. Please pray for her and her family.

The annual All-Class Reunion for Little Flower School is this coming Saturday November 3. We are hoping that many alumni will attend. Please see information elsewhere in the bulletin. Pass the word along to school alumni. Reservations are due by Monday, October 29.

Because of the All-Class reunion, there will be no confessions on Saturday, November 3.

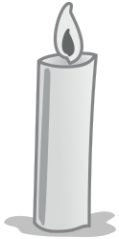

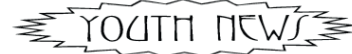
