Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. 

High School Placement Test

Scecina Memorial High School requires incoming freshmen to take the High School Placement Test (HSPT) in order to enroll at Scecina. Scecina academic advisors use the test results to gain a better understanding of each incoming student's needs. Along with ISTEP results, report cards, and teacher recommendations, the information is used by the Scecina Memorial Admissions Committee to assess a student's academic readiness. The final test date for this year is January 12, 2019. Register by calling the Enrollment Office at 317-356-6377, ext. 1327. Scecina also accepts results from the HSPT taken at other Catholic High Schools. Scecina offers three HSPT scholarships.


