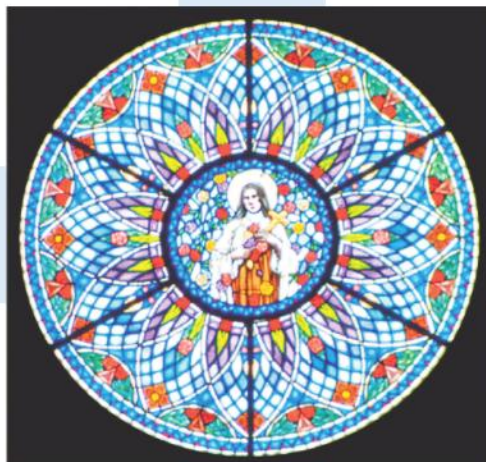

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 10:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Dear Parish Family,

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, commonly known as Corpus Christi. Today we celebrate our faith in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. In

the former Sacramentary, there was a beautiful alternate opening prayer for today's Solemnity:

Lord Jesus Christ, we worship you living among us in the sacrament of your body and blood. May we offer to our Father in heaven a solemn pledge of undivided love. May we offer to our brothers and sisters a life poured out in loving service of that kingdom where you live with the Father and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.

There are also three other major feasts this week. Tomorrow, Monday, June 24, is the Solemnity of The Nativity of Saint John the Baptist. Friday is the Solemnity of The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. Saturday is the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles. Saturday is also my 44th anniversary of ordination by St. Pope Paul VI.

Since our 8th grade class has graduated, I want to thank them for the gifts they gave me: a "World's Best Bus Driver" hat & a dark chocolate candy bar. You might wonder why they chose that hat. Although I tell everyone that I wanted to be a priest since I was six years old, children often ask what I might have become if I had not become a priest. My answer has always been a teacher, a lawyer, or a bus driver.

I plan to leave on vacation this Friday, June 28. I will return to the office on Wednesday, July 10. If all goes as planned, I will begin radiation treatment for prostate cancer on Monday, July 15.

During my vacation, there will be Communion Services on weekdays. However, the bulletin will include the dates and times of Masses at Holy Spirit and Our Lady of Lourdes.

Next weekend, June 29 and June 30, Fr. Joe Moriarty will be the celebrant and homilist at all the Masses. As most of you know, Fr. Joe is the son of Pat and Margaret Moriarty. He grew up in Little Flower Parish and attended both Little Flower School and Seccina Memorial High School. Currently he serves as rector of Bishop Simon Bruté College Seminary here in Indianapolis. He will be here to promote his ministry at the seminary by talking about the work of the seminary in his homily. There will be envelopes in the pews that weekend, and a second collection will be taken for the support of the seminary. Please welcome Fr. Joe, and please be as generous as possible.

This past year Chris Arvin, our parishioner and deacon candidate, was the director of RCIA and of our high school Confirmation program. He did an excellent job in both roles. However, he has asked to only be responsible for one of the programs for 2019-2020. I have asked him to continue as director of the high school Confirmation program. Lisa Gibbons has agreed to resume her role as director of RCIA. She was a member of the RCIA team from 1992 to 2018 and was the director of RCIA from 2004 to 2018. I want to thank both of them for accepting responsibility for these important programs.
