



SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 10:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

SUMMERFEST 2019

The best estimate of the net profit from this year's festival will end up very close to \$65,000. This is about \$3,000 less than last year. The primary cause for the decline was the main raffle, which was down approximately \$4,000 from last year. Overall expenses were also higher. That being said, we did experience respectable increases in several areas, including the silent auction, stained glass raffle, and elephant ears! Income for each day of the actual event also showed a slight increase. The festival profit will cover the majority of the cost of necessary repairs and upgrades to the rectory, including a new roof and cooling system.

Next year we plan to work hard to increase not only profit, but volunteerism. Many volunteers worked more than one shift in different areas. Quite a few booth chair people stayed in their booths the entire time. By engaging more volunteers, we can enable everyone to have a little more time to get out and enjoy the festival.

A festival wrap-up meeting with the leadership team has been scheduled for Wednesday, June 26, at 6 p.m. at which time we will look at the results in greater detail.

We were blessed with great weather all 3 days of the festival! I received positive feedback all weekend and beyond, and everyone who attended seemed to enjoy themselves very much.

I would like to thank each and every person who was involved in making Summerfest 2019 – Summerfest of Love – a successful event! Our festival leadership team is second to none, and all of the volunteers worked extra hard all weekend to keep everything running smoothly. Thanks also to everyone who came out to enjoy Summerfest!
