### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 10:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Dear Parish Family,

Today we welcome Sister Theresia Hhayuma, a member of the Congregation of the Daughters of Mary-Tabora, Tanzania, who will speak to us about the work of the Daughters of Mary-Tabora and ask for our prayers and financial support. Please be as generous as possible.

Tuesday is the Feast of the Transfiguration of Jesus. Jesus' transfiguration showed the apostles that Jesus was the fulfillment of the Old Testament Law and the Prophets. It also helped prepare them for his impending death and resurrection by giving them a glimpse of his future glory.

On August 6, 1978, St. Pope Paul VI died at the age of 80. Pope Paul VI was elected Pope in 1963 after the death of St. Pope John XXIII. He was thrust into the role of continuing the Second Vatican Council. As most of you know, Fr. Jim Farrell and I and 357 others were ordained by Pope Paul VI on June 29, 1975. Most people saw him as distant and austere. However, at the kiss of peace, I saw tremendous warmth in his eyes. His feast day is May 29.

Last Sunday at the 6 p.m. Mass we had our annual blessing of high school and college students as they prepare to return to school. During the homily, I mentioned how I look forward to them returning in the spring and let them know that we will miss them during the year. They often do not recognize what a gift they are to the parish. When young people attend and participate in Mass, especially when they participate in liturgical ministries, they bring life to the parish.

As a parish, we encourage young people to be active both in liturgical ministries and in other ministries. For example, high school students help with Confirmation preparation because they often can have a greater impact on younger students than adults have. They can be powerful witnesses of faith, love, and hope.

Today I want to invite and encourage our younger parishioners to become involved and engaged in our parish life and ministries.

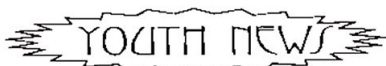
