Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held every other month. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

Dear Parish Family,

**Days 4-7 of the Little Flower Novena will take place Monday through Thursday at 5:30 p.m.** Each day will consist of the novena prayers, a reading from Fr. Ron Rolheiser, and a Communion Service.

Please mark your calendars for **the Solemn Closing of the Little Flower Novena on Tuesday, October 1, at 5:30 p.m.** and for the **Parish Appreciation Brunch Sunday, October 6, in the Social Hall after the 10:30 a.m. Mass.**

This Friday, September 27, is the feast of St. Vincent de Paul. We need to thank all the members of the Little Flower conference of the St. Vincent de Paul Society for their ministry to those in need within our parish boundaries. They are fulfilling Pope Francis' call to reach out to those on the peripheries.

September 27 is also the 59<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the death of Fr. William Vollmuth. Fr. Vollmuth was one of the most popular Little Flower associate pastors. He served at Little Flower from June 18, 1947 until October 7, 1957. In 1959, Fr. Vollmuth became the founding pastor of St. Jude Parish on the Southside.

Next Saturday, September 28, Fr. Mike Welch will be here for Mass and confessions. Please welcome him warmly. I lived with Fr. Mike for eighteen years at St. Christopher. Next Saturday I will celebrate my niece Meghan and her fiancé Evan Siegrist's wedding here at Little Flower and then attend their reception.

This past Tuesday, actually the feast of St. Robert Bellarmine, my patron saint, I completed my radiation treatments. Thank you once again for all the prayers, cards, and well wishes. I truly believe that it was because of your prayers that I did not have any unpleasant side effects. However, I would ask for your continued prayers. We will not know the results of the treatment for approximately six weeks. At that time, I will have my PSA checked and see the radiation oncologist for the results. Also, on September 12, I saw my primary care doctor for my annual physical. One of my blood result numbers was off. I will need to have that re-checked in mid October.

There is one correction to my homily last Sunday. The last two years the school was slightly over 50% non-Catholic. I just found out that this year the school is 52% Catholic.

Finally, this past week we had to throw away one of our relatively new hymnals because a child had drawn in it and stuck candy in it. New hymnals are not inexpensive. Also, most of our hymnals were purchased by parishioners to honor loved ones. This particular hymnal was donated by a parishioner to honor her deceased husband. Parents, please make sure your small children do not play with hymnals and that your older children treat them with respect.
