Therefore, tomorrow is a Holyday, but not a Holyday of Obligation. I still would encourage you to attend Mass tomorrow because this is the patronal feast day of the United States.

**Our Advent Penance Service will be next Monday, December 16, at 7:00 p.m. at Our Lady of Lourdes.** Several priests will be available to hear confessions. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is a good way to put ourselves in the right frame of mind to prepare for the birth of Christ. Our Lenten Penance Service will be here at Little Flower.

Thursday, December 12, is the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. This feast recalls her apparitions to St. Juan Diego at the hill of Tepeyac from December 5 to December 12, 1531. Pope Pius XII declared her patroness of the Americas.

Saturday, December 14, is the 24<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the death of Fr. Robert Borchertmeyer, who was associate pastor from 1958 to 1968 and pastor from 1985 until his death. Please remember to say a prayer for Fr. Bob this Saturday.
