SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGEContact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. Today we want to pray for all families that they will model themselves after the Holy Family. However, with all the violence in the world, we also want to pray for the human family that we all see ourselves as children of the same God and, therefore, brothers and sisters of one another.

Wednesday, January 1, is the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, a Holyday of Obligation. Masses will be Tuesday evening at 6:00 p.m. and Wednesday morning at 9:30 a.m. Wednesday is also a Day of Prayer for Peace and New Year's Day. The parish office will be closed on Wednesday, January 1.


\$20 entry fee - 75% of fees go to the winners: 1st, 2nd & 3rd place!

Progressive Euchre tournament format (using a score card) - 8 hands per round and move on with a change of partners.


Euchre side pot: \$0.25 goes into a pot when you get euchred; the person with the most loners at the end of the tournament gets the pot!
