

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times previous Call the Dariab Office well and the advance Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

This weekend we welcome Fr. Jim Bonke for the Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass and the Sunday 9:30 a.m. Mass and

Next weekend Fr. Phil Bowers will be here for all three Masses and for confessions on Saturday afternoon. Fr. Phil is the retired pastor of Holy Spirit Geist in the Diocese of Lafayette. Prior to becoming a priest of the Diocese of Lafayette, Fr. Phil was a Maryknoll Missionary. Please welcome him next weekend.

Until my return, there will be no weekday Masses or Communion Services. Please check elsewhere in the bulletin for the weekday Mass schedules for Holy Spirit, Our Lady of Lourdes, and St. Philip.

Tomorrow we celebrate the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul. As most of you know, on June 29, 1975, Fr. Jim Farrell and I were ordained in St. Peter's Square by now St. Pope Paul VI. During the ceremony, each of us went up to Pope Paul VI twice, once for the imposition of hands and once for the sign of peace. Although Pope Paul VI appeared distant in pictures and at audiences and ceremonies, I saw great warmth when I looked into his eyes. Tomorrow is also the ninth anniversary of Archbishop Thompson's ordination as a bishop.

Friday is the Feast of St. Thomas the Apostle. Thomas is often called "Doubting Thomas" because of his initial unwillingness to believe in Jesus' resurrection. When Jesus challenged his lack of faith, Thomas responded, "My Lord and my God!" He is associated with the founding of the Church in southern India.

Friday is also 34th anniversary of the death of Father William Buhmeier. Fr. Buhmeier was associate pastor here at Little Flower from March 30, 1960 to October 4, 1960 and from May 1, 1963 to February 5, 1966.

FESTIVAL NEWS

Dear Parish Family,

It is with a heavy heart that we must announce the cancellation of Summerfest 2020. The festival committee met last week to discuss the many factors that led to the final decision. Because festival planning (even on a smaller scale) needs to begin 4 to 5 months in advance, and given all of the uncertainty surrounding COVID-19 and the restrictions we may need to put in place, it was nearly impossible to plan for such an event. Below are some of the primary factors that led to the decision:

- The City of Indianapolis has suspended the issuance of Special Event Permits, and we were told they did not know when permit issuance would resume.
- The Indiana Gaming Commission has yet to respond to emails and phone calls regarding a gaming permit.
- If social distancing were to be mandated, it would be extremely difficult to manage and monitor.
- Volunteerism would be down due to concerns with the virus.
- The uncertainty of attendance numbers makes food planning very challenging.
- Most importantly, the safety and protection of our parish family and surrounding community is a high priority for us.

Because the proceeds from the festival were intended to fund a cooling system for the rectory, we are exploring another option to raise funds for that project.

We very much appreciate all of the kind words of support we have received over the past several months regarding the festival. We hope to be able to bring you a spectacular Summerfest in 2021!
