We want to thank Archbishop Thompson for celebrating and preaching last Sunday's 9:30 a.m. Mass. I found his homily thought provoking. This was his first visit to Little Flower since he became Archbishop. We did not know that he was coming until earlier in the week. As bishop of Evansville, he had been here on October 9, 2014, to celebrate the funeral of Fr. Jim Rogers, a priest of the Diocese of Evansville.

On Monday, we were notified that the bishops of Indiana have decided to extend the dispensation from the obligation of Sunday Mass attendance until November 1:

While commending our pastors and pastoral life coordinators who have gone to great lengths to assure safe worship spaces in our churches, due to the increase in the COVID-19 cases in our state, the Indiana bishops have decided to extend the dispensation from the obligation of Sunday Mass attendance beyond August 15 until November 1, 2020, unless further developments determine otherwise.

Although no explanation was offered, I am confident that the bishops of the Province of Indiana made this decision to protect those who are more vulnerable to COVID-19. I am equally confident that it was not their intent to discourage anyone from attending Sunday Mass.

Currently Little Flower School will open on Thursday, August 13, for in-person or online classes. New teachers this year include: Katie McGannon (Music), Angie Robb (Grade 6 & 7 English & Language Arts), Madeline Van Meter (Grade 2), and Micayla Watroba (Grade 3). Welcome to all of them and to all our returning administration, faculty, staff, and students and their families.

Saturday, August 15, is the Solemnity of the Assumption. On the Solemnity of the Assumption, we celebrate our belief that at the end of her earthly life Mary was assumed body and soul into heaven. This dogma was defined by Pope Pius XII on November 1, 1950. We will celebrate the Solemnity with an anticipated Mass on Friday, August 14, at 6 p.m.
