

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Dear Parish Family,

This weekend we welcome Fr. Larry Richardt for the Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass and the Sunday 9:30 a.m. Mass. Fr. Larry is a retired priest of the Archdiocese who is an excellent homilist. I very much appreciate his willingness to come this weekend.

The Little Flower Novena will continue Monday through Thursday evening at 5:30 p.m.

Thursday, October 1, is the Feast of St. Therese. There will be an All-School Mass on Thursday at 9:30 a.m. Because of Covid, several grades will attend in person, and several grades will watch the live stream of the Mass.

The Solemn Closing of the Little Flower Novena will be Thursday, October 1, at 5:30 p.m. The Solemn Closing will consist of the traditional procession with the relic of St. Therese with those preparing for First Communion dropping rose petals, the novena prayers, and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. I hope that many of you will make a special effort to attend.

We will also celebrate the Feast of St. Therese at all the Masses next weekend, October 3 and 4.

Tuesday, September 29, is the Feast of Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael Archangels. Michael means "Who is like God?" Gabriel means "God's Strength." Raphael means "God's Remedy." All three are mentioned in the Bible. References to Michael can be found in the Book of Daniel 10: 13 & 21 and 12:1, the Letter of Jude 1:9, and the Book of Revelation 12:7. References to Gabriel can be found in the Book of Daniel 8:16 & 9:21 and in the Gospel of Luke 1:19 & 26. Finally, references to Raphael are found throughout the Book of Tobit: "So Raphael was sent to heal them both: to remove the cataracts from Tobit's eyes, so that he might again see God's sunlight; and to marry Raguel's daughter Sarah to Tobit's from her" [3:17].

Friday, October 2, is the feast of the Holy Guardian Angels. The Guardian Angel prayer was the very first prayer I learned in first grade.

Saturday, October 3, which was formerly the Feast of St. Therese, is now the Feast of St. Mother Theodore Guerin, the foundress of the Sisters of Providence in Terre Haute and the principal patroness of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis. She is the only Indiana saint.

According to Indy Hunger Network's 2017 Unmet Need Study, food insecurity affects one out of every five people in Indianapolis. The study also found community members were not using food pantries due to the lack of information to locate a food pantry. It also found individuals and families were not

enrolling into SNAP/WIC benefits because of ineligibility concerns. One of the problems facing people who are food insecure is knowing where to turn for assistance. Finding nutritious, readily available food shouldn't be hard. That is why the Indy Hunger Network created **Community Compass**, a free and easy app designed to show people where they can find food assistance in Marion County.

With Community Compass, people can find free meal locations, free groceries, food-related events, and information on WIC, SNAP, and other programs. If you have a smart phone, you can download the Community Compass app. If you don't have a smart phone, you can text "hi" to 317-434-3758 to find assistance. Questions? St. Vincent de Paul urgently needs volunteers at our Food Pantry as members of the National Guard will end their temporary, six month deployment at the end of September. We are so grateful to the National Guard who have filled a critical gap and provided the workforce needed to keep our Food Pantry open. We have seen dramatic drops in volunteers and cannot continue effectively without more help. SVdP is eager to welcome volunteers regularly to safely distribute food to our neighbors.

We have adapted our operations to prioritize the safety of volunteers and provide food to those in need while following public health guidelines.
