Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received are habitised instruction are suited to a particular properties. pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year.
