SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

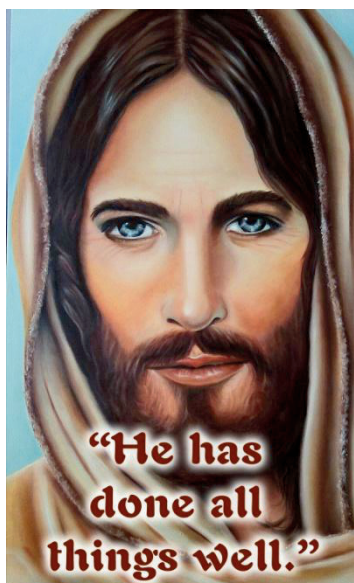

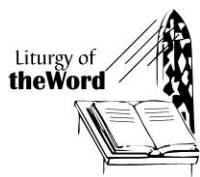

THE RESUMPTION OF ADULT CHOIR

Our current plan, assuming no outside restrictions will be imposed, is to resume Adult Choir with practice on **Tuesday, September 7, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.** in Church. Recent communication indicates the majority of choir members are anxious to return. However, based on the fact that spreading the virus is more significant during singing than speaking, face masks will be required for choir members. The situation will be monitored and modified appropriately. **We appreciate the willingness of choir members to live with this restriction temporarily. (It's not easy to sing with a mask on!)**

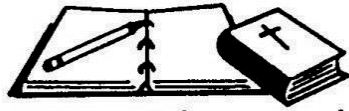

30th Street Food Pantry Returns to Indoor-only Shopping

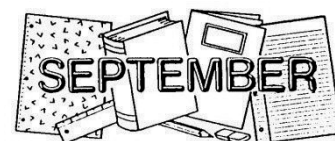

New pantry shopping days/hours (effective 9/7) will be: Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday 8 a.m.-12 p.m. and Thursday evening 5-7 p.m.

For the protection of our SVdP family, those not vaccinated are asked to continue wearing a mask indoors or in areas where social distancing is not possible. For those fully vaccinated, we strongly recommend following ISDH and CDC guidance for mask wearing indoors.

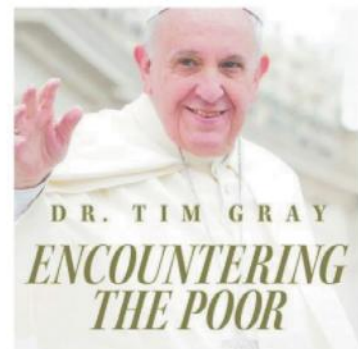
