SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Dear Parish Family,

Please plan on attending our annual Halloween Bash this weekend on Sunday, October 31, from 3:00 - 5:00 p.m. Please note the time is different due to Sunday evening Mass. There are more details elsewhere in the Theresean. *Halloween* stands for *All Hallows Eve*, in other words, the eve of All Saints.

We resumed Children's Liturgy of the Word on September 12 at the 9:30 a.m. after being put on hold during the pandemic. It has been a huge success! There have been between 8-15 children attending each week! It is life-giving each week to watch our little ones participating, and it is life-giving to them as well. However, we need your help! We need more adult leaders to help with this wonderful ministry. Please think about helping out. More information is provided elsewhere in the Theresean.

On Monday, November 1, we will celebrate the Solemnity of All Saints. On All Saints Day, we remember and give thanks for the special people in our lives who have died and who are now with God. Normally All Saints Day is a Holyday of Obligation. Because it falls on Monday this year, it is not a Holyday of Obligation. There will be an all-school Mass at 9:30 a.m. and the Mass of Remembrance at 6:00 p.m.

Our Mass of Remembrance is important for those who have lost family members this past year, but it is also important for us as a parish. At this Mass, we support families of parishioners who have lost loved ones, but we also remember and celebrate the lives of so many individuals who were an important part of our parish. Therefore, I invite and strongly encourage you to attend to help us remember our deceased parishioners and your own deceased family members and friends.

Tuesday, November 2, is the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, commonly called All Souls Day. On this day, we pray for all the faithful departed who may need our prayers. There will be an all-school Mass at 9:30 a.m. and an evening Mass at 5:30 p.m. All Souls Day provides us another opportunity to pray for our beloved dead. Historically, the month of November, especially All Souls Day, was a traditional time for visiting the graves of deceased loved ones.

Both All Saints Day and All Souls Day remind us of the unbreakable bond between us and those who have gone before us in death. We ask all the saints in heaven to pray for us, and we pray for all the souls in purgatory.

This Thursday I will celebrate Mass for the Sisters at Oldenburg. Therefore, there will not be a Mass here on Thursday.

The annual All Class Reunion for Little Flower School is this coming Saturday November 6. We are hoping that many alumni will attend. Please see information elsewhere in the Theresean. Pass the word along to school alumni. Reservations are due by Monday, November 1. At this year's dinner, we will honor James Rose, Class of 1971, David Smock, Class of 1985, and Stephanie Wendel-Sponsel, Class of 2002.

Because of the All-Class reunion, there will be no confessions on Saturday, November 6.

Finally, although our numbers of parishioners attending weekend Masses slowly continues to grow, very few parishioners are attending weekday Masses. Recently I celebrated a Mass with just two parishioners in addition to me. The word *Eucharist* means thanksgiving. Whenever we celebrate Eucharist, we give thanks to all for all the gifts God has given us directly or indirectly through others, especially the gift of Jesus who makes all love possible. Most daily Masses are at 5:30 p.m. Please check the Theresean weekly for the Mass schedule.

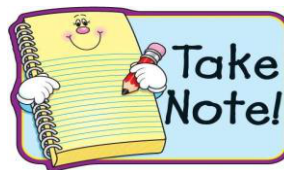
Thanksgiving Blessing Bags

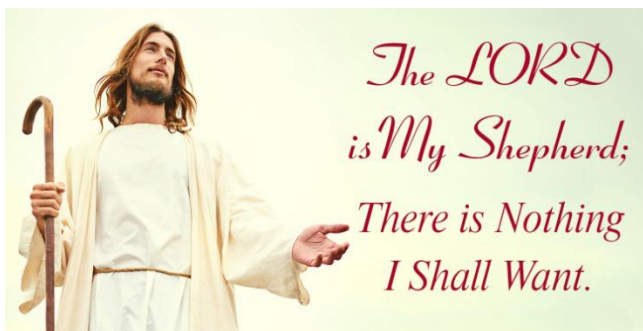
the 9:30 a.m. Mass last Sunday, so 100 bags are being filled!
