Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

Our primary celebration of Christmas should be Christmas Mass with our family, friends, and parish family. At Christmas Mass, we thank God above all for the gift of Jesus, the embodiment of God's love for us.

Christmas Masses will be Friday, Christmas Eve, at 4:00 p.m., 5:30 p.m., and 10:00 p.m., and

If you plan to attend the 5:30 p.m. Mass, please know that you do **not** need to arrive very early to get a good seat. The 5:30 p.m. Christmas Eve Mass is never crowded.

The Christmas Choir will sing at the 10:00 p.m. Mass on Christmas Eve. They will begin singing at 9:25 p.m. Also, there will be incense at the 10:00 p.m. Mass. This Mass will be live-streamed on our Facebook page beginning at 9:25 p.m.

The parish office will be closed Friday, December 24, and Monday, December 27.




