Dear Parish Family,

This Monday, January 17, our nation celebrates the birth of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Both our parish office and our school will be closed in honor of Dr. King. I am always moved by Dr. King's words in his "I Have A Dream" speech delivered on the steps of the Lincoln Memorial on August 28, 1963: "I have a dream that my four children will one day live in a nation where they will not be judged by the color of their skin but by the content of their character." In that same speech, Dr. King reminded his listeners, "...unearned suffering is redemptive."

Tuesday begins the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity (January 18-25). January 25 was and is the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul. The theme for

2022 is "We saw the star in the East, and we came to worship Him" [Matthew 2:2]. According to the Greymoor Ecumenical and Interreligious Institute, "Each year in January, the Church recalls the visit of the Magi to Bethlehem, highlighting God's invitation to all of humanity to a new covenant in the Incarnation of Christ."
