Dear Parish Family,

Friday is the 30<sup>th</sup> World Day of Prayer for the Sick. This year's theme is "Be merciful, even as your Father is merciful" (Lk 6:36). In his message for this year's World Day of Prayer for the Sick, Pope Francis wrote that God's mercy "combines strength and tenderness. For this reason, we can say with wonder and gratitude that God's mercy embraces both fatherhood and motherhood (cf. Is 49:15). God cares for us with the strength of a father and the tenderness of a mother; he unceasingly desires to give us new life in the Holy Spirit."

Next Sunday, February 13, at the 9:30 a.m. Mass, we will celebrate the Rite of Enrollment and Illumination with the 2nd graders making their First Eucharist this spring. The children have been learning about how we celebrate as a family and as God's people. This rite reinforces their baptism and reminds them that as Christians we are especially happy because we know that Jesus is present with us when we come together to celebrate. At this rite, the children will be called forward by name.
