

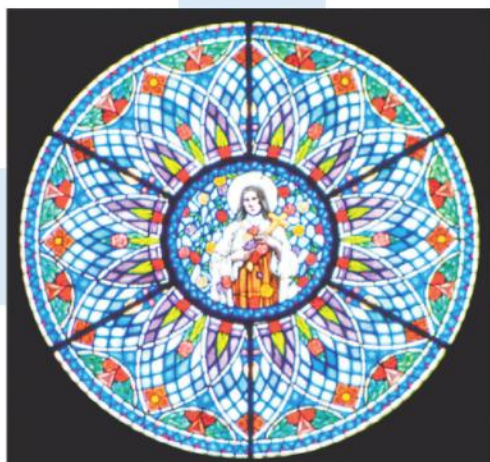

### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

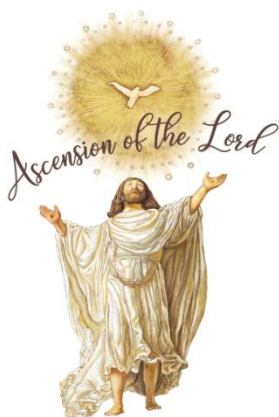

Dear Parish Family,

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. Today we celebrate Jesus' return to His Father and his glorification at the right hand of his Father. At the Last Supper, Jesus said, *"But I tell you the truth, it is better for you that I go. For if I do not go, the Advocate will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you"* [John 16:7]. During the week between Ascension and Pentecost, the Church asks us to pray for a new outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Church and upon the world.

Monday is Memorial Day. Memorial Day is a day to remember those who gave their lives for our country. Our Memorial Day Mass will be at 9:30 a.m. Also, the parish office and the school office will be closed on Monday.

Traditionally Memorial Day was a day to remember those who gave their lives for our country. For example, Lt. Ruth M. Gardiner, a 1928 graduate of Little Flower School, was the first Army flight nurse to give her life in the service of her country during the second World War. In July 1944, a United States Army Hospital in Chicago was named in her memory.

However, because of the numbers of military personnel who have returned home with catastrophic injuries from more recent wars and conflicts, I would suggest that in addition to praying for those who have made the ultimate sacrifice for our country and for freedom, we pray for those who have suffered catastrophic injuries and for the safety of all of our military personnel wherever they may be.

On Tuesday, May 31, the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Little Flower's eighth grade graduation will begin with Mass at 6 p.m. All are invited to attend the Mass and graduation. We congratulate our graduating eighth graders and wish them the best in high school.

This year's closing all-school Mass will be Wednesday morning at 9:30 a.m. All are invited. At this Mass, we will give thanks for all the blessings of this school year and pray for the safety of our Little Flower School community during summer vacation.

Its success depends upon your support. The East Side Crusaders concluded their 2022 Track season campaign. It was a great season!! We had the most kids (30) since we combined in 2017 with equal numbers coming from Little Flower, Holy Spirit and Our Lady of Lourdes. At the CYO Championships we had 25 Personal Records, 8 East Side Crusader Records and 13 Top 9 finishes. Given there were 900+ kids competing across 6 divisions – nice job!!!! For the season we achieved 19 Team Records.

Your Little Flower classmates that achieved an East Side Crusaders Team Record this season include:

- Cadet Girl Ximena Zarga-Diego in the 1600M (Mile) @ 6:01.5 and 800M (1/2 Mile) @ 2:43.82.
- Bella Montgomery, competing as Cadet, now holds the Girls Shot Put record with a distance of 22'11"
- Isaac Young now holds the 400M record with a time of 1:00.5
- Ximena was part of the record setting team in both the 4x100M and 800M relays
- Isaac Lathrop was part of the 5/6th Grade Boys record setting 800M relay

Special congratulations to the 2022 CYO 4x100 Meter Cadet Boys City Champions. Isaac Young was Runner 1 and Eric Montgomery was our anchor leg. They raced to a 50.02 time with great baton exchanges. Ultimately just .59 seconds off the all-time CYO record!!!

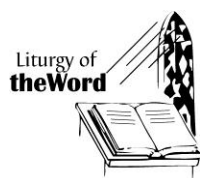

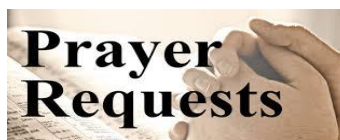
