Dear Parish Family,

Today we welcome our visitors who are attending Summerfest 2022.

Today we celebrate Pentecost, the sending of the Holy Spirit. The word *Pentecost* means the fiftieth day. Pentecost was the Greek name given to the Jewish Feast of Weeks, which fell on the fiftieth day after Passover. Our Pentecost falls on the fiftieth day after Easter. Today also marks the end of the liturgical season of Easter. During the Easter Season the Paschal or Easter Candle is lit at all Masses. After today, the Paschal or Easter candle will only be lit for baptisms and funerals.

Tomorrow we return to Ordinary Time. During Ordinary Time, "the mystery of Christ itself is honored in all its fullness." During Ordinary Time, green vestments are worn. In the Liturgy, green is the color of hope. Monday we celebrate the feast of Mary, Mother of the Church, a feast established by Pope Francis in 2018.

Sunday, June 19, is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, commonly known as Corpus Christi. It also marks the beginning of a three-year Eucharistic Revival throughout the United States. Information concerning the opening celebration in the Archdiocese of Indianapolis can be found at https://eucharisticrevivalindy.org/festival which is scheduled from 1 p.m. until 6:30 p.m. I would encourage as many of you as possible to participate in one or more parts of this celebration.

There will be two Masses celebrated by the Archbishop. The 1 p.m. Mass will be primarily in English; the 3:00 p.m. Mass will be primarily in Spanish. There is a free luncheon and service project. There will be a Eucharistic procession from Sts. Peter and Paul Cathedral to St. John's ending with a Holy Hour and Benediction. Some have wondered if we are going to cancel our regular 6 p.m. Mass. It does not seem appropriate to us to cancel our Sunday evening Mass, the only Sunday evening Mass in the East Deanery, when we are trying to foster Eucharistic Revival.

Schedule for the Opening of the Eucharistic Revival, Archdiocese of Indianapolis: June 19, 2022

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops is leading a National Eucharistic Revival, which will take place from 2022-2025. The Revival launches on the Feast of Corpus Christi, June 19, 2022. Over the next three years, dioceses will host events focused on strengthening our belief in the Eucharist. The local events will culminate in a National Eucharistic Congress, which will be held from July 17-21, 2024 in Indianapolis.

The Archdiocese of Indianapolis will open the Eucharistic Revival locally with a special event on June 19, 2022. The opening event will include two Masses, a Festival of Faith, Family, and Service, an outdoor Eucharistic procession, and a Holy Hour. The events will take place in downtown Indianapolis at SS. Peter & Paul Cathedral, the Archbishop Edward T. O'Meara Catholic Center, and St. John the Evangelist Church. Participants are encouraged to attend any portion of the day's events that fit into their schedules come for part of the day or all of the day.
