Dear Parish Family,

I announced at Mass last weekend this year's festival profit is just over \$82,000; however, the amount has changed since that time. We received more income through the silent auction and donations, and the profit is now over \$83,000. This is a new record, beating the old record by about \$6,500. Thank you for your help, support, and patience during the craziness that is Summerfest! We could not have accomplished this without all your help and prayers.

I hope to leave on vacation this Thursday, June 30, and plan to return on Tuesday, July 12.

During my vacation, there will be no Masses or Communion Services on weekdays. However, the bulletin will include the dates and times of Masses at Holy Spirit, Our Lady of Lourdes, and St. Philip Neri.

Next weekend, July 2 and 3, there will be three visiting priests. Fr. Jim Bonke will be the celebrant and homilist at the Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass. Fr. Bonke is a retired priest of the Archdiocese who served as Defender of the Bond at the Tribunal. Fr. Joe Rautenberg will be the celebrant and homilist at the Sunday 9:30 a.m. Mass. Fr. Rautenberg is a retired priest of the Archdiocese who continues to serve the Archdiocese as a consultant on ethics and bioethics. Fr. Rick Ginther will be the celebrant and homilist at the Sunday 6:00 p.m. Mass. Fr. Rick is the pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes. He was associate pastor here from 1983-1985.

Today is the anniversary of the death of Bishop Simon Bruté, the first bishop of the Diocese of Vincennes, which included Indianapolis. He died in 1839.

Tuesday is the feast of St. Irenaeus, bishop and martyr. St. Irenaeus wrote that the Son of God became what we are that he might make us what he is himself. In other words, the Son of God became human that he might make us who are human what he is himself, i.e., sons and daughters of God.

Tuesday is also the anniversary of the death of Bishop Maurice de St. Palais in 1877. He was the fourth bishop of the Diocese of Vincennes.

Wednesday is the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul. As most of you know, on June 29, 1975, 47 years ago, Fr. Jim Farrell and I were ordained in St. Peter's Square by now St. Pope Paul VI. During the ceremony, each of us went up to Pope Paul VI twice, once for the imposition of hands and once for the sign of peace. Although Pope Paul VI appeared distant in pictures and at audiences and ceremonies, I saw great warmth when I looked into his eyes. Now retired, Fr. Jim lives in his family home here in Little Flower Parish.

Wednesday is also the eleventh anniversary of Archbishop Thompson's ordination as a bishop.

In case you missed it, Fr. Bob announced at Masses last week that the net profit from the festival finished at just over \$82,000. That figure has been updated. Due to additional money that recently came in through the silent auction and donations, the profit now stands at over \$83,000! This beats our old record by more than \$6,500.

Expenses were about 7.75% higher than last year, but fortunately our income increased 8.25%. We saw our largest increases in sponsorships, the silent auction, and the wine booth. Looking day by day, the income for Friday realized a 22% increase over the same day last year!

The festival profit will go towards the installation of a new roof on the parish center.

We were blessed with amazing weather all 3 days of the festival! Your prayers worked! Positive comments were pouring in all weekend and beyond.

Our festival leadership team is a fantastic group of volunteers who plan the festival from January to June, and Summerfest would not happen without them. Huge thanks to them! Also big thanks to all who participated in Summerfest 2022 in any way, whether it was volunteering, donating, selling raffle tickets, or attending and enjoying the festival. We are already excited for next year!
