Special thanks to Lisa Gibbons who serves as director of Vacation Bible School. The theme of the week was "Monumental -Celebrating God's Greatness." The program reminded the children that God is always with us.

Today is the anniversary of the death of Fr. Thomas Finneran in 1968. Fr. Finneran served briefly as associate pastor Little Flower in the early 1960's.

Monday is the feast of St. Alphonsus Liquori, bishop and doctor of the Church. St. Alphonsus was a lawyer who founded the Redemptorists. He was one of the greatest moral theologians in the history of the Church. Cardinal Tobin was a member of the Redemptorists.

Thursday is the feast of St. John Vianney, the Curé of Ars. He is the patron saint of priests, especially parish priests. He heard confessions for 16 hours/day during the summer and up to 11 hours/day in the winter. Thursday would be a good day to pray for an increase of vocations to the priesthood.

Saturday is the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord. Every year the Gospel of the Transfiguration is read on the Second Sunday of Lent. According to an ancient tradition, the transfiguration occurred 40 days before Good Friday.

Saturday is also the anniversary of the death of St. Pope Paul VI in 1978. Pope Paul VI ordained Fr. Jim Farrell and me. I remember visiting my mother and my aunt on that day and hearing Little Flower's bells announcing his death.

Also, it was on August 6, 1945 that the first nuclear bomb was dropped on Hiroshima. On August 9, 1945, a second nuclear bomb was dropped on Nagasaki. Today we are living in troubled times. Saturday we should also pray for peace in the world.

On a personal note, as much as I love chocolate, please do not bring me any chocolates. Once again, I have to minimize my intake of chocolate. Thanks for understanding.


