### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Please welcome Fr. Jim Farrell who will be the celebrant and homilist for our Saturday evening Mass this weekend. Fr. Jim is a retired priest of the Archdiocese who lives in Little Flower in the home in which he grew up. He currently serves as chaplain coordinator for Seccina Memorial High School.

This Monday, September 5, is Labor Day. Mass will be celebrated at 9:30 a.m. The parish office as well as Little Flower School will be closed on Monday.

I would encourage all those who are able to attend Mass on Monday. Labor Day celebrates the contribution of workers to the common good of our society and the prosperity our country enjoys. Labor Day is a good day for us to thank God for the economic blessings we enjoy and to pray for the health and safety of all workers and for those who are unemployed or under-employed. "The Dignity of Work and the Rights of Workers" is one of the seven principles of Catholic Social Teaching.

## Join Our Golf Outing



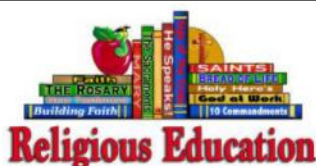

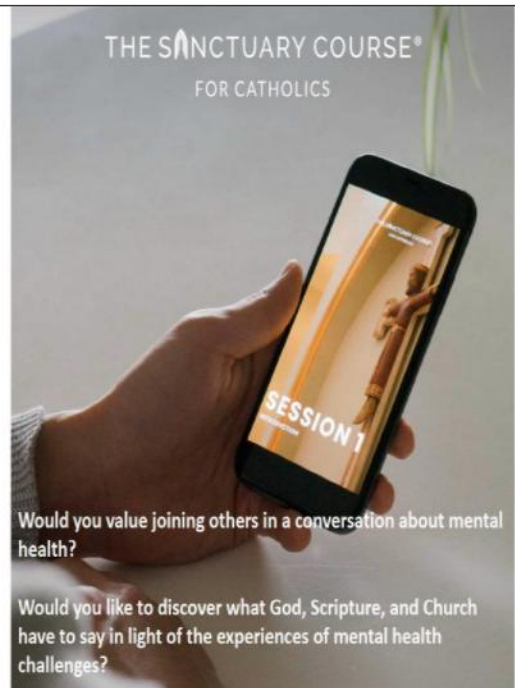

Would you value joining others in a conversation about mental health?

Would you like to discover what God, Scripture, and Church have to say in light of the experiences of mental health challenges?

The subject matter feels particularly relevant in these times of heightened anxiety, and the course creates an opportunity to connect with and support each other in meaningful ways.

**ABOUT THE COURSE**

The Sanctuary Course for Catholics is an eight-part course for small groups designed to raise awareness and start conversations regarding mental health. Topics covered include: mental health and mental illness, stigma, recovery, companionship, self-care, and community. The sessions are accompanied by compelling films that feature the stories of Catholics living with mental health challenges, along with the insights of archbishops, theologians, and psychologists. There is no homework, but it's recommended that you read/listen to the sessions in advance of meeting.
