### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

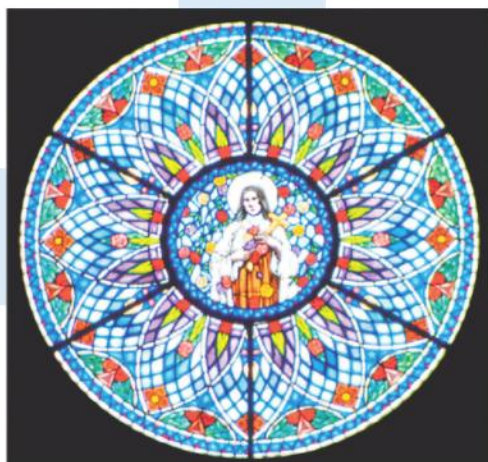

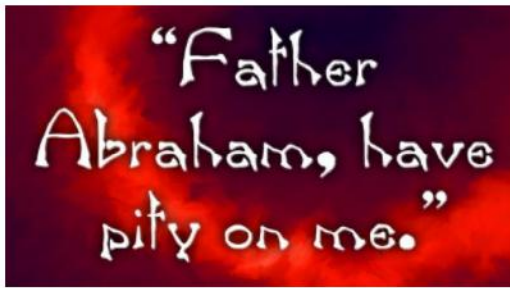

Dear Parish Family,

**Days 4-8 of the Little Flower Novena will take place Monday through Friday at 5:30 p.m.** Each day will consist of the novena prayers, a reading, and a Communion Service.

Saturday, October 1, is the Feast of St. Therese. We will celebrate her feast at all the Masses next weekend.

**The Solemn Closing of the Little Flower Novena will be Saturday, October 1, at the 5:00 p.m. Mass.** The Solemn Closing will consist of the traditional procession with the relic of St. Therese and those preparing for First Communion dropping rose petals, the 9<sup>th</sup> day novena prayer, and the Mass of St. Therese. I hope that many of you will make a special effort to attend.

As I noted in last week's *Theresean*, the 1945 Jubilee Brochure described the first Little Flower Novena: "The first public novena in honor of the Little Flower came to a close on her feast, September 30, 1927. ...Closing night, an estimated 1500 persons were present." Since her canonization, St. Therese has had three different feast days: September 30, October 3rd, and now October 1.

Likewise, I hope many of you will be able to attend the **Parish Appreciation Dinner next Saturday, October 1, in Duffey Hall after the 5:00 p.m. Mass.** This dinner is a "thank you" for the time, talent, and treasure generously given by our parishioners that make our parish the wonderful faith community that we all enjoy. Please come and allow us to show our gratitude in this small way. Everything will be provided, so just bring yourselves. Please RSVP to the parish center at 317-357-8352 as soon as possible.

Congratulations to parishioner Kevin Echegaray. He went through the naturalization ceremony and became a citizen of the United States on Wednesday, September 14, at the Indianapolis Public Library along with 116 others from 44 different countries. Kevin was born in Peru and moved to Indianapolis a little over 20 years ago. His immediate family all live here in Indianapolis/Avon. His wife, Cassie, teaches math to grades 3 to 5 at Little Flower. She also serves as a Eucharistic Minister. Two of their three children currently attend Little Flower School.

Likewise, congratulations to school parent Dahlia Valencia-Zepeda who also became a US citizen on September 14. She is the mother of Hector, Andrea, Jose, and Camila.

Tuesday, September 27, is the 62<sup>nd</sup> anniversary of the death of Fr. William Vollmuth. He was born on July 13, 1915 in Terre Haute and was ordained on May 26, 1942 at St. Meinrad. From 1942 to 1947, he served as assistant pastor at Holy Trinity, Evansville, St. Mary's, New Albany, and St. Mary's, Rushville. Fr. Vollmuth was the assistant pastor at Little Flower from June 18, 1947 to October 7, 1957 when he was appointed pastor of St. Martin of Tours in Siberia, Indiana. In 1959, he was appointed the founding pastor of St. Jude parish in Indianapolis. Fr. Vollmuth died on September 27, 1960 at the age of 45 after suffering a massive heart attack. During his time at Little Flower, Fr. Vollmuth was very popular with the young people of the parish. I remember attending his farewell party with my parents and brother when I was in third grade.
