

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Dear Parish Family,

This weekend we are celebrating the Feast of St. Therese at all the Masses. Saturday evening we are also celebrating the Solemn Closing of the Little Flower Novena with the traditional procession with the relic of St. Therese and the 2nd graders who are preparing to receive First Eucharist dropping rose petals

Saturday, October 1, is her feast day. This is the third date for her feast. Her feast was originally on September 30, the anniversary of her death in 1897. From 1927-1969, her feast day was on October 3. One of the reasons for this date was because October 1 was not available because of the then current liturgical calendar. One website suggested that it was moved to October 1 because of an ancient custom of celebrating a saint's entry into heaven on the day following their death.

St. Therese was named a Doctor of the Church by St. Pope John Paul II on October 19, 1997.

Monday, October 3, is now the Feast of St. Mother Theodore Guérin, the Principal Patroness of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis, our only Indiana saint. St. Mother Theodore founded the Sisters of Providence at St. Mary-of-the-Woods. On Monday, please pray for our Archdiocese and especially for the Sisters of Providence who continue her work. I am sure that many of you, especially those who are older, were taught by Sisters of Providence at some point in your education.

Tuesday, October 4, is the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi. On Tuesday, please pray for the Sisters of St. Francis, Oldenburg. The Sisters of St. Francis, Oldenburg, staffed Little Flower School from its beginning until approximately 1993 when Sr. Alice Ann retired from teaching. For almost 30 years, the entire faculty were Sisters of St. Francis, Oldenburg. When I was in school, October 4 was always a free day.

Wednesday is the optional memorial of St. Maria Faustina Kowalski who is venerated as the "Apostle of Divine Mercy."

Friday, October 7, is the Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary. The Rosary is one of the principal devotions to the Blessed Virgin Mary. When those of us who are older were growing up, there were three sets of mysteries: the Joyful, Sorrowful, and Glorious Mysteries. St. Pope John Paul II added the Luminous Mysteries: the Baptism in the Jordan, the Wedding at Cana, the Proclamation of the Kingdom, the Transfiguration, and the Institution of the Eucharist.




