

### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.



Dear Parish Family,

Thanks to everyone who attended our Thanksgiving Day Mass. Also, special thanks to those who brought food and/or gave in the collection to assist the St. Vincent de Paul Society. Despite the economy, we all have much for which to be grateful. God is indeed the giver of all gifts, both divine and human.

Today is the First Sunday of Advent. Advent is a time to prepare to welcome Christ more deeply into our minds, hearts, and lives this Christmas. In the past many of you have participated in Matthew Kelly and Dynamic Catholic's email program. If you have not already signed up for this year's program, *Best Advent Ever 2.0*, you can sign up at the Dynamic Catholic website: <https://www.dynamiccatholic.com/>. This year's *Best Advent Ever*

program has two tracks: "Best Christmas Ever" or "Let Your Soul Shine."

Our Advent Penance Service this year will be this Thursday, December 1, at 7 p.m. here at Little Flower. We will be joined by the parishioners of Our Lady of Lourdes and our children preparing for First Communion. At least six priests are scheduled to be available for confessions, including one who speaks Spanish. Jesus gave us the Sacrament of Reconciliation as a gift, not a burden. Please take this opportunity to be reconciled to God and others.

For those who are unable to attend our Penance Service, Holy Spirit's Penance Service will be Wednesday, December 14, at 7:00 p.m. Also, we have confessions every Saturday from 3:45 to 4:30 p.m. However, there will be no confessions on Christmas Eve.

Wednesday is the Feast of St. Andrew, the Apostle. It is the 29<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the death of Fr. James R. Hoffman who was assistant pastor of Little Flower from February 9, 1955 until September 18, 1958. Because he was assistant pastor when I started first grade, he is one of the first priests I remember.

Saturday, December 3, is the Feast of St. Francis Xavier, the Principal Patron of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis. Today we should all pray to St. Francis Xavier for the Church in the Archdiocese of Indianapolis. St. Francis Xavier was a missionary to India, Sri Lanka, Malaysia, and Japan. He and St. Therese are the co-patrons of the Apostleship of Prayer and of the missions.

Two weeks ago, I mentioned our three new outstanding alumni. The first was June Ann Nally Jorgenson, Class of 1953. She was the younger of two daughters of Louis and Ernestine Nally, who were parishioners at Little Flower from 1943 until 2002. June was a woman ahead of her times. For example, in third grade, she was left in charge of her classroom for an entire afternoon.

She became the first of her 54 first cousins to go to college. When she entered college in 1957, she was not interested in nursing or teaching or finding a husband. She wanted to go into business with her father, so she took as many business classes as she could, often as the only female in the class.

In 1966 she was a stay-at-home mom with two boys. When her husband, John, lost his job during an economic downturn, she went to work at Indiana National Bank as a junior clerk typist in the mortgage loan department. In 1969, when she was in line for a promotion at the bank, she and John decided she would continue to work and he would stay at home, an unpopular decision at that time. The same year they also decided she would work full time, attend college, and get a business degree. She graduated in 1975 with an accounting degree and passed the CPA exam. In 1999, she retired after 33 years of service and three mergers as the Vice President of Trust Tax Operations for the State of Indiana.

Recently she became a hospitality minister at the 5 p.m. Mass, welcoming people as they enter church for Mass, taking up the collection, and distributing bulletins as they leave.

She wrote, "The education I experienced at Little Flower was the foundation for everything that happened after."

For being a woman ahead of her time, a pioneer, and for being a faithful member of Little Flower Parish, we honored June Ann Nally Jorgenson as an outstanding alumna of Little Flower Catholic School.


