If you forgot to bring your blessed palms from 2022 with you last weekend, you may bring them next Sunday, and we will burn them for you.

Tuesday I will be at the semi-annual Priest/PLC meeting in Bloomington.

Next Sunday, April 30, 21 children will make their First Communion at an added Mass at 11:30 a.m. All are invited. Also, their Blessing Cups are displayed on the Altar this weekend. Please pray for our First Communicants and their families during this special time.

Last Sunday Carol Wehlage, Cac Diehr, and Cindy Woods spearheaded our second New Parishioner Brunch, a joint effort of the Welcoming Committee and *Invite* Commission, for those who joined our parish between September 15, 2022 and February 26, 2023. Our new parishioners were able to meet some of the parish staff in addition to leaders of many of our parish ministries. They also enjoyed a delicious brunch!

Little Flower's St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) ministry is part of a larger city-wide ministry. Normally each parish in the Archdiocese has a SVDP conference that aids families living within the parish boundaries. This assistance can be food, clothing, household goods, and/or monetary help in the form of rent or utility payments. Our conference also organizes our Thanksgiving Food Bags and the Giving Tree program at Christmas.

For the last several years our St. Vincent de Paul conference consisted of two very dedicated workers, Pat Dunn and Judy Corpuz. These wonderful women, both in their eighties, have been a part of SVDP for over 20 years. However, due to the limited number of people in our conference, they were not able to do home visits, which is one of the main goals of SVDP, to be the face of Christ for our less fortunate neighbors. I would like to take this opportunity to thank Pat for her many years of service to SVDP and to thank Judy for her continued involvement. I would also like to thank all past members of Little Flower's SVDP conference for all of their support.

I am happy to say that our SVDP conference has been resurrected, thanks to the efforts of Peggy Clegg in recruiting new members. Little Flower now has a new group of dedicated volunteers who started working with St. Vincent de Paul, beginning on Easter Monday, April 10, in an effort to assist our neighbors in need. Membership includes the following individuals: Frank Mackell, President; Peggy Clegg, Spiritual Director; Bev Moore, Treasurer; and Phone Call Triage, Dianna Deputy. Other members who will assist them are Pattiann Gavaghan, Rita Chapman, Cathy Wellner, Judy Corpuz, Jeannie Zimmerman, Beth Leszcynski, and Katie Leszcynski.

Since they began their outreach efforts on Easter Monday there have been seven requests for assistance and four home visits scheduled. Currently members are meeting every two weeks to provide support to our neighbors in need. The need for assistance is great!

Our primary means of helping our neighbors in need is through the financial assistance we receive from the Fifth Sunday of the Month SVDP envelope included with our monthly envelopes. Any monies we receive from this collection is used to help our neighbors in need with utility bills, rent assistance, etc. The more money we receive the more help we are able to give. Our next Fifth Sunday of the Month collection will be next weekend, April 29-30, so if you are able, please try to support this worthwhile ministry.
