Dear Parish Family,

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, the sending of the Holy Spirit. The word *Pentecost* means the fiftieth day. Pentecost was the Greek name given to the Jewish Feast of Weeks, which fell on the fiftieth day after Passover. Our Pentecost falls on the fiftieth day after Easter. Today also marks the end of the liturgical season of Easter. During the Easter Season the Paschal or Easter Candle is lit at all Masses. After today, the Paschal or Easter candle will only be lit for baptisms and funerals.

Tomorrow we return to Ordinary Time. During Ordinary Time, "the mystery of Christ itself is honored in all its fullness." During Ordinary Time, green vestments are worn. In the Liturgy, green is the color of hope.

Monday is Memorial Day. Memorial Day is a day to remember those who gave their lives for our country. Our Memorial Day Mass will be at 9:30 a.m. Also, the parish office and the school office will be closed on Monday.

Sunday, June 11, is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, commonly known as Corpus Christi. It also marks the beginning of the second year of the three-year Eucharistic Revival throughout the United States. The second year focuses on parish Eucharistic Revival. The Archdiocese of Indianapolis has suggested that parishes mark the beginning of the second year with a Eucharistic procession.

Our Eucharistic procession will take place following the 6 p.m. Mass on Sunday, June 11. Weather permitting, we will process around the block and return to church for Benediction. Please consider joining us for this special procession.

SUMMERFEST 2023 is this weekend, **Friday, June 2-Sunday, June 4.** Please check out all the bulletin announcements concerning **SUMMERFEST 2023**, which is our largest fund raiser each year. Its success depends upon your support. In the last several years, we have made quite a few improvements to the church building, the school, and the parish center, thanks to proceeds from the festival. The funds raised this year will be earmarked for replacing the HVAC system in the Parish Center. Over the last few years, we have had to spend a significant amount of money repairing leaking pipes in the Parish Center. Also, we are still using window air conditioners in the building.

- 1. Please sell as many raffle tickets as possible. Memorial Day gatherings are a good time to sell raffle tickets.
