Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

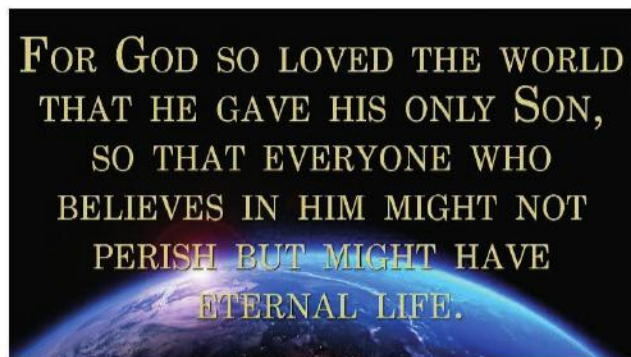

Dear Parish Family,

Today we welcome our visitors who are attending Summerfest 2023.

Today we celebrate Trinity Sunday. Today we celebrate our faith in three Persons in one God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. 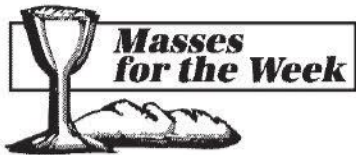

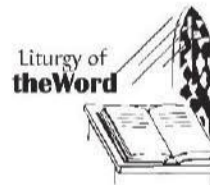

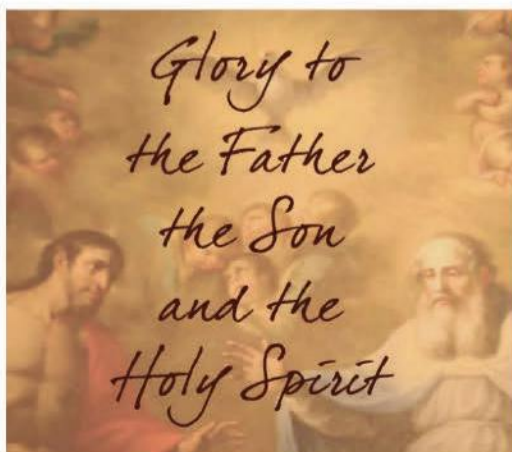
