#### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

#### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

#### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Dear Parish Family,

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of the Lord, often called Corpus Christi. Today we celebrate our faith in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

Today also marks the beginning of the second year of the three-year Eucharistic Revival throughout the United States. The mission of the Eucharistic Revival is "to renew the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist." The second year focuses on parish Eucharistic Revival. Little Flower will mark the beginning of the second year with a Eucharistic procession this Sunday evening following the 6 p.m. Mass. The procession will conclude with Benediction. You may remember that last year on Corpus Christi there was a

1.7-mile Corpus Christi procession from the Cathedral of SS. Peter and Paul to St. John the Evangelist Catholic Church.

As you know, Tom's retirement date was June 1, 2023. Today I would also like to update you on the status of our search for a new Music Director. In January, I formed a search committee composed of several parishioners and Charlie Gardner, a former Music Director at Little Flower and former head of the Office of Worship for the Archdiocese. On Thursday, May 25, I offered the job to one candidate. However, last Saturday the individual declined our offer. After taking a pre-planned vacation, Tom has graciously agreed to continue with his job duties as we resume the search.

SUMMERFEST 2023 was wonderful!!! For the sixth festival in a row, we were blessed with perfect weather. Notwithstanding the heat, the humidity was low, so it was not too uncomfortable. We can only be grateful to God for the beautiful weather. We thank those who prayed for good weather.

Every year as SUMMERFEST approaches, so many people become involved: festival volunteers, parishioners selling raffle tickets, and parishioners coming to the festival and encouraging others to come. I am always amazed by the number of volunteers who are here throughout the entire festival, often volunteering in various capacities. In addition, some of these were the same people who worked hard both on set-up and take-down. SUMMERFEST benefits the parish not only financially but also builds community within the parish and brings the larger community together.

Likewise, a successful festival requires a strong Festival Committee. Special thanks go to the Festival Committee. Their advance work contributes greatly to the success of the festival. Also, during SUMMERFEST, all the members of the Festival Committee play leadership roles. Special thanks to them.

We also have to be grateful to all our sponsors and to all those who donate goods and services for the Silent Auction and especially our friends at the Steer-In for providing the fried chicken dinner Saturday evening. The Silent Auction, which is our biggest source of profit, is probably the most labor intensive for the committee that organizes it. The Silent Auction committee begins their work in January.

Special thanks to Angie Mackell. As Director of Stewardship and Administration, she has primary responsibility for the festival. Also, special thanks to Jacob Comley, our Director of Maintenance, who has many jobs to do for the festival both before and after the official set-up and take-down times.

Vacation Bible School will be held July 17-21, 2023 from 6:30 -8:30 p.m. and is open to children entering pre-4 through fourth grade. We also need youth (5th grade and above) and adult volunteers. Please mark this on your calendar and register your children soon. There is an early bird registration fee until July 5. There is more information elsewhere in the bulletin.

At his Angelus address last Sunday, Pope Francis made a beautiful point about the Sign of the Cross:

With the simplest gesture, with this sign of the cross, by tracing the cross on our body, we remind ourselves how much God loved us, to the point of giving His life for us; and we repeat to ourselves that His love envelops us completely, from top to bottom, from left to right, like an embrace that never abandons us.


