The following weekend, July 8-9, Fr. Jim Farrell will be the celebrant and homilist at the Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass. Fr. Jim Bonke will be the celebrant and homilist at the Sunday 9:30 a.m. Mass, and Fr. Rick Ginther will be the celebrant and homilist at the Sunday 6:00 p.m. Mass.

Saturday, July 8, will be 61st anniversary of the dedication of Little Flower Church. Archbishop Paul C. Schulte dedicated the church on Sunday, July 8, 1962.

Today, June 25, is the anniversary of the death of Fr. Jerome Pfau, the second pastor of Little Flower. Fr. Pfau died in 1957. Monday is the anniversary of the death of Bishop Simon Bruté, the first bishop of the Diocese of Vincennes, which included Indianapolis. He died in 1839.

Wednesday is the feast of St. Irenaeus, bishop and martyr. St. Irenaeus wrote that the Son of God became what we are that he might us what he is himself. In other words, the Son of God became human that he might make us who are human what he is himself, i.e., sons and daughters of God.

FESTIVAL NEWS

The best estimate of the net profit from this year's Summerfest will finish just over \$76,000. Although down approximately \$7,000 from last year, this net profit falls in line with our most profitable festivals prior to the exceptional year we had in 2022!

While overall income was down about 6.25%, expenses were also down 4%, which helped our bottom line. The overall decrease in expenses was due to our ability to return unused goods because of the lighter crowd.

Areas that performed exceptionally well this year were sponsorships, the stained glass raffle and the silent auction. In fact, each of these had their best year ever! It needs to be noted that the silent auction is responsible for nearly 30% of the festival profit. Their long and hard work really pays off!

This year's festival profit will go towards a new heating and cooling system for the parish center.

I can never express enough thanks to the extraordinary festival leadership team and the volunteers that make Summerfest happen. I am humbled by the hard work that is poured into this event that folks largely accomplish in their spare time. You are simply the best!

Big thanks also goes to all who participated in Summerfest 2023 to make it a success, whether it was buying/selling raffle tickets, bidding on silent auction items from wherever you happened to be located, or attending the festival. Little Flower is extremely grateful! ~Angie
