Dear Parish Family,

Today we welcome Jim Tidaback who will be speaking on behalf of the African Sisters Education Cooperative. By educating African Sisters, the Cooperative improves their ability to serve their communities and to make a difference in their communities. Please be as generous as possible.

My gratitude goes out to the Men's Club for their help in tending the grounds and for their help with the all-school cookout on Thursday, July 13. However, we are most familiar with the story of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead.
